Helping to build sustainable communities up to £10,000

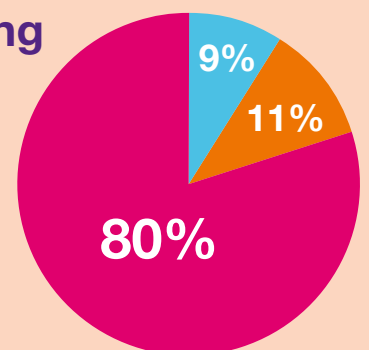
