- **No environmental incidents**

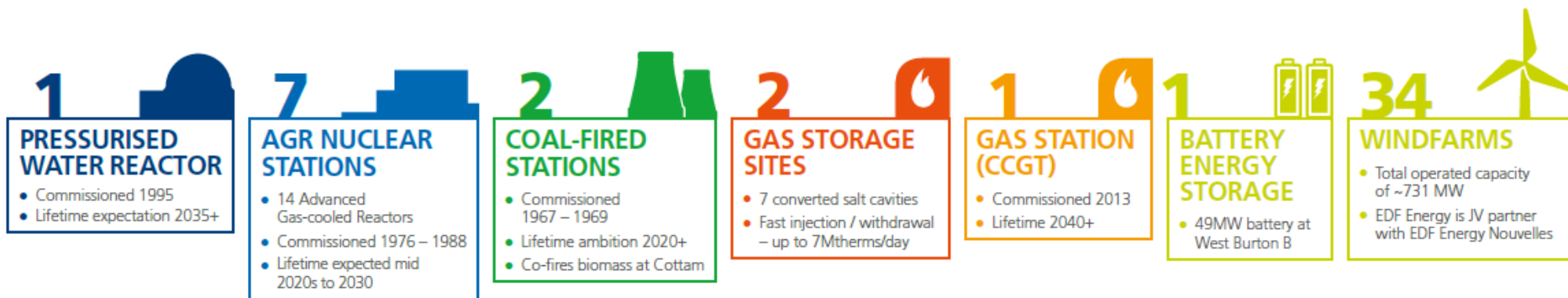
- **539 EDF Energy staff includes 16 Apprentices, 3 trainees, 3 Industrial Placements**

Company News – Two ground breaking projects opened by EDF Energy

- EDF Energy officially opened the Blyth off-shore wind farm and the West Burton B battery storage facility.
- Blyth off-shore wind farm, Northumberland, is composed of five turbines with total generation capacity of 41.5 MW.
- Blyth is the first off-shore wind farm to use float and submerge technology.
- 49 MW battery storage facility located at West Burton B power station is the largest project in the new frequency control system which will be deployed across the UK to improve stability of the national grid.



Planned shut down of Turbine Generator 1

- In August we plan to shutdown Turbine Generator 1 to conduct a repair to a low pressure heater tube.
- Planned turbine outage for approx. 6 days
- Turbine Generator 2 will not be affected during this time.

- EDF Energy has completed work on Sizewell beach to remove the exposed, what is thought to be, WW2 invasion defences.
- They appeared on the shoreline following a storm earlier in the year.
