AIM 1 Mitigating the socio-economic impact of decommissioning over £10,000

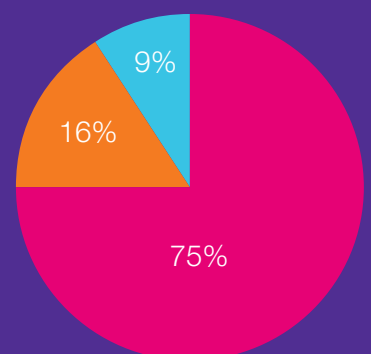
AIM 2 Helping to build sustainable communities up to £10,000
